



Can of Worms Camporee

This fall we will try something new. On Saturday October 7th, Troops may come to Camp Olmsted for a fall camporee. Troops may arrive any time during the afternoon or evening to set up. On Sunday October 7th, we will make patrols from all campers and proceed to the C.O.P.E. course for a day of fun activities. While at the course, the Scouts will cook their own lunches with food that will be provided by us. Since Monday is a day off from school, Troops are free to stay Sunday night and do troop activities on Monday as long as they have the required leadership. Troops need to provide their own food for all meals except Sunday lunch. Campfires will be allowed but in a raised container. The camp has a limited number of containers available. A minimal fee of three dollars will be charged and will cover the cost of lunch and a patch. The patches will not be ordered until we have a final count, so they will not be available at the camporee. We will have an opening campfire and will have some sort of program or speaker. A "Scouts Own Service" will be held Sunday morning before breakfast. Please sign up at the Betts Scout Service center by September 22nd. The event will be cancelled if we do not have at least 8 scouts signed up by that date.
